

# **\* COVID-19 NOTICE \***

To all clients, guardians of clients, relatives, acquaintances, caretakers, and any parties whatsoever that are entering UAA's pool facility, you are required to read and acknowledge the following prior to entering the facility:

- (1) UAA has taken significant steps and safety measures, including requiring parties and UAA staff to adhere to reasonable social distancing measures, that it can to try and limit the exposure to any party entering its facility to the Covid-19 virus, and/or any communicable disease.
- (2) However, UAA cannot eliminate and/or prevent the possible exposure to any party entering its facility to a communicable disease.
- (3) Furthermore, while UAA can impose reasonable social distancing measures, it cannot prevent its instructors from having some physical contact and/or being in close proximity to clients.
- (4) Accordingly, by entering the facility, you are hereby accepting the risk of possible exposure to the Covid-19 Virus and/or any communicable disease, and thus releasing UAA and/or any of its owners, instructors, representatives, etc. from any

possible liability and/or claims related to such possible exposure to the Covid-19 Virus and/or any communicable disease.

(5) Additionally, if you, your child, or any party you are with is exhibiting, or has exhibited, any symptom of the Covid-19 virus, or any communicable disease, either at this time and/or within the past seventy-two (72) hours, then you may not enter the facility. Such symptoms include, but are not limited to, fever, sore throat, runny nose, cough, any rash of any kind, difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, loss of taste or smell. If you have recently been diagnosed and/or tested positive for the Covid-19 virus, then it is your responsibility to determine when it is safe for you to leave isolation and/or to attend any public facility or to leave your home. Thus, UAA asks that you have consulted your doctor for instruction on when you may leave isolation, and that you have followed the explicit guidelines set out by the CDC to leave isolation. The CDC provides information on the Covid-19 virus, including proper precautions for those who have been diagnosed with Covid-19 and/or who have exhibit symptoms of Covid-19 at the following website:

At a minimum, UAA requires that you must **wait at least five (5) days after Recovery**, which is defined by the CDC as “resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and

improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and at least ten (10) days have passed since symptoms first appeared” to attend UAA’s facility.

If you are uncertain about any of the above provisions, please do not enter the facility.
